1. Whitchurch Motor Club will organize a Clubman's Auto test on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2016 at

2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.

3. MSA Clubman's Permit No. 98299 has been granted, and will be on display on the day.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to members of Whitchurch Motor Club, & Harper Adams motor club.

Priority will be given in order of receipt of fully paid entries. Anyone who is not a member may apply for membership of Whitchurch MC, giving membership until 31 December 2017.

All drivers must produce valid club membership cards. A competition licence is NOT required.

Entries may be accepted from drivers of the age of 16 at the date of the event, or 17 and over without a RTA Licence, but they may only drive a 4 seat saloon type "Touring Car", of less than 1400 cc. Forced Induction is not permitted

### 5. PROGRAMME

### 6. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

All cars must comply with MSA Technical Regulations M16 -17.3

**ALL** Cars must compete on road legal tyres.

## 7. CLASSES

The Clubmans event will consist of :-

A- Production Saloon's.

B- Sports Cars.

C- Specials.

Petrol engines with forced induction by turbo or supercharging will have their capacity increased by 1.4. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes.

## 8. AWARDS

Fastest Time of the Day

1st in each Class (subject to 3 or more starters)

2nd in each Class (subject to 5 or more starters)

Best Whitchurch mc member.

Best Harper Adams motorsport club member.

1<sup>st</sup> U17 driver.

No competitor may win more than one award. **Awards may be presented at a later date.**

## 9. ENTRY

The entry list opens on publication of these SR's and closes finally at 19.00 hrs. on 25th **November 2016**.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

**The entry fee per competitor is £ 20.00**

All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. However, a text to **DAVE EVANS**, including vehicle details, drivers name etc., will book a place on the entry list, subject to availability.

## 13. MARKING AND PENALTIES.

Time taken completing the course = Actual time taken

Striking a cone or barrier or any other course marker = 5 seconds per offence

Failure to stop astride the stop line = 5 seconds

Taking an incorrect route on any course (Wrong Test)\* = Maximum Time

Completing a test in a time exceeding the maximum = Maximum Time

**Maximum time = quickest time in class for that course, plus 20 seconds**

**\*NOTE:** If a driver returns to the point of their mistake, and then completes the test correctly, a wrong test does not apply. **The Marshals decision will be final.**

## 14. GENERAL:

Each driver will have two or more runs at each layout, all runs, including penalties; will be used in calculating the results.

Competitors will start in their own time upon clearance from the timekeeper. Timing will start when the front wheels cross the timing line. Timing will stop when the front wheels cross the flying finish line. The car must stop astride the stop line if further penalty is not to be incurred.

A Stop Signal will be displayed if there is an obstruction on the course. A competitor must stop immediately on deployment of the signal and a re-run allowed. The Stop signal will be displayed at the drivers briefing.

**Cont.**

In the event of a tie the fastest run of the first course will determine the tie, and then the fastest on the second course, etc until the tie is resolved. To be classified as a finisher, competitors must start at least one run at all courses.

**Practising will not be allowed.**

All competitors will have an opportunity to walk each test layout before timed runs start for that course.

**15. IDENTIFICATION:**

Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers, which should be clearly displayed in the driver's side rear window or nearest equivalent.

**16. GENERAL REGULATIONS**

The MSA General Regulations apply as written except for the following amendments:-

G10: Judges of Fact: All officials, and marshals, will be judges of fact for the purposes stated in M8.

D17.5 : A vehicle may be entered twice to be driven by different drivers, but no driver may drive more than one car.

Table M.7.5: Timing will be by hand held stop watches to the previous tenth of a second. Penalties shall be as SR13 above.

M19.5 Pylons may be less than 1 Metre in height.

**17. RESULTS:**

Provisional results will be on display throughout the event and as soon as possible at the end of the event at which point any protest must be lodged in the correct manner, in accordance with C5, within 30 minutes. Otherwise results will become final and the awards presented.

**Results will be sent out by e-mail as soon as possible after the event. If you wish to receive copies of results by post, please include a stamped addressed envelope.**

**18. PAPERWORK:**
